REGULATIONS:

- 1. A total of 10 to 20 sheep will be used.
- 2. Dogs must be kept quiet and away from the area while another dog is competing.
- 3. Next competitor must be available with his/her dog 10 minutes before they are due to compete.
- 4. Dogs biting or pulling wool will be penalised.
- 5. At judge's discretion dogs may be disqualified.
- 6. Dogs wearing muzzles will be penalised 4 points.
- 7. The competitor may retire at any time.
- 8. Dogs taking excessive time will be rung off
- 9. In the event of a draw, a runoff will be conducted for 1st place only, otherwise the fastest time will apply.
- 10. The winning score will be the aggregate of both runs.
- 11. No dog may be substituted for a dog already nominated less than 24 hours before a trial commencing or at convenors discretion.
- 12. The judge's decision will be final.
- 13. Competitors are to leave the gates as found.
- 14. Competitors may assist the dog in keeping the sheep flowing, but assistance may be penalised.
- 15. If a competitor's dog bites or injures a member of the public in anyway, it is the owner's responsibility.
- 16. Dogs should be listed in order of preference in case of balloting.

The judge will address all competitors at 7.15am Saturday and 8.15am Sunday unless otherwise notified by the convenor
